OTHER CAMP INFORMATION

Smoking Areas. There are two designated smoking areas with a white bucket containing sand: in the area below the Weyerhaeuser Lodge and in the small parking lot to the east of the King Leadership Building. Smoking is also allowed at fires as long as others enjoying the fire don't mind.

Refrigerators. Small refrigerators for those who need them for personal medications or special diets can be found in the King Leadership building and the Savannah Lodge.

Fires. Depending on environmental conditions, we may have several fire rings available to us. If conditions are too dry, fires and other burning objects will not be allowed. If conditions are favorable, fires will <code>only</code> be allowed in the following areas: the fireplace on the River Center patio, the fire ring near the Flag Pole, the fire ring outside Cabin 8 and the fire ring at the Totem Pole in the South Village. These fire rings will have a water bucket readily available. Do NOT leave a fire pit unattended – you are responsible for putting out the fire when you leave the area. The fireplace on the River Center patio has a metal screen that should be put in place when leaving the area. Wood will be provided by the camp; please keep fires to a small cozy size. We will announce Friday night at mass dancing whether or not fires will be allowed.

Swimming and River Access. There is no swimming or wading at the camp beach. A public swimming beach is available a short distance south of the camp at Troy Beach. Swimming is at your own risk. MWMA insurance does not cover swimming. Please be aware that the river may be high and dangerous this time of year. Children should be with an adult.
